# STORY OF "SABARI MATHA"

The abode of Swamy Ayyappan is Sabarimala. These mountain ranges got the name Sabarimala from Sabari matha, a staunch devotee of Lord SreeRama !!

Shabari was a hunter's daughter and belonged to the Nishadha tribal community. The night before her marriage, she saw that thousands of goats and sheep were brought by her father, which were going to be sacrificed for the marriage dinner. Moved by compassion, during the early hours of the morning, she renounced the world and ran away in search of a Master. After days of travelling, she met Sage Matanga at the foot of the Mountain Rishyamukha and accepted him as guru, serving him with devotion. When her guru Matanga was about to die, Shabari-now an old woman-said that after serving him throughout her life, she wanted to reach the same "abode of peace" which Matanga reached. There upon, the sage said that by the virtue of her seva (service), Lord Ram shall give her darshan and asks her to wait for his arrival. Saying this, the sage sitting in lotus posture attains Mahasamadhi. As per her guru's words, Shabhari anticipated for the arrival of lord Rama.

Everyday Shabari would go out of her ashram, with the help of a walking stick and pluck berry fruits for Lord Ram. She would pluck a fruit, first taste it, and if it was sweet, she would put it in her basket and discard the bitter ones. She wanted to give the good and sweet fruits only to Ram. The thought never came to her that she should not taste it before it was offered to a deity. Thus collecting a few fruits, Shabari went back to her ashram and eagerly anticipate Ram's arrival.

While Sri Rama was in the search mode of Sita Devi, He reached Shabari's place. Even though hundreds of other yogis were waiting to receive Rama in their ashrams, Rama went only to Shabari's ashram because of her sincere devotion/ true bhakti. Shabari offered the fruits she

had meticulously collected to Rama. When Rama was tasting them, Lakshmana raised the concern that Shabari had already tasted them and therefore unworthy of eating. To this Rama said that of the many types of food he had tasted, "nothing could equal these berry fruits, offered with such devotion". Pleased with Shabari's devotion, Rama blesses her with His divine Vision. Shabari also tells Rama to take help from Sugreeva and where to find him. The Ramayana says that Shabari was a very bright and knowledgeable saint.

Rama delivers His discourse on navavidha bhakti (ninefold devotion) to Shabari : "First is satsang or association with love-intoxicated devotees and righteous people. The second is to develop a taste for hearing My nectar-like stories. The third is service to the guru. Fourth is to sing My kirtan (communal chorus). Japa or repetition of My Holy name and chanting My bhajans are the fifth expression. To follow scriptural injunctions always, to practise control of the senses, nobility of character and selfless service, these are expressions of the sixth mode of bhakti. Seeing Me manifested everywhere in this world and worshipping My saints more than myself is the seventh mode of bhakti. To find no fault with anyone and to be contented with one's lot is the eighth mode of bhakti. Unreserved surrender with total faith in My strength is the ninth and highest stage. Shabari, anyone who practises one of these nine modes of My bhakti, pleases Me most and reaches Me without fail. That which is most difficult for the greatest yogis was easily attained by you, Shabari, because of your sincere devotion."

The holy place-mountain, where Shabari Matha did her tapas/penance and attained moksha, thousands of years ago in Treta Yugam, is the abode of Lord Dharmasastha/Ayyappa and is known in Her name as Sabarimala.

> Ayyappa Yogam is the basic unit of SASS. The meaning of the word 'Yogam' is 'coming together' and the word 'Ayyappa' is added because Lord Ayyappa Himself organised Ayyappa Yogams during his life time. The Birth Star of Lord Ayyappa is 'Uthram' and every month the day of Uthram star, is celebrated as Uthram Pooja. Some of the other major regular events are Ayyappa Sangamams, Guruswami Sangamams and Mahila conventions. Celebrating Makara Jyothi as another deepavali, Prathishta dinam (idol installation day), Onam, Vishu, Chithira Attathirunal, Mandala Makaravilakku, Festival- all these more-auspicious days are divinely celebrated in the Ayyappa Yogams.

Conducted NEC Meeting – video conference mode- on 13th May 2020. Presided over by National Chairman. 15 National/State level office bearers attended.
3 Regional Meetings conducted by National

5 Regional weetings conducted by National Executive Karyakarthas – Chairman, General Secretary, Treasurer, Organising Secretary and Admin Secretary and attended by about 60 State level Karyakarthas on May 16, 17, 18 & 22. Next round of Central and Region-wise meetings are planned from June 1 to 7th. Press Nets uwas relageed on 20th April 2020 by Press Note was released on 20th April 2020 by the National Chairman & General Secretary condemning the heinous murder of two poojya Rishies along with their driver at Palghar in Maharashtra state and to Order for immediate enquiries by the Central Agencies The control out the persons in the conspiracy. Protest notes were issued against proposed auction/sale of Gold, lamps, vessels, etc. in temples for non temple related activities and illegal encroachment in the forest land in the Sabarimala trekking route by some people of minority community. Various State and minority community. Various State and District Committees also had issued such Protest Notes.

A protest press note was issued on 5th May 2020 by the Kerala State Committee against the transfer of Rs.5 er to Kerala CM's Relief Fund from the Guruvayur Devaswaom,

which is unlawful and against the interests of the temple. While disposing cases filed by various Hindu organizations, Hon High Court of Kerala ordered against the transfer of any more funds in future and the matter was

more funds in future and the matter was referred to a larger bench. Kokan Pranth has already started their new web-newsletter Ayyappavani last month. They have arranged national level competitions in "Drawing of Ayyappa", "singing SASS prayer" and "Global Ayyappa" songs singing competon". NEC directed all Ayyappasevaks to arrange separate service activities and also support Government agencies in the fight against

Government agencies in the fight against COVID

Most of the states have reported their service activities, mainly supply of masks, food materials and annadanam to the poor, needy persons - badly affected by COVID related

restrictions. National General Secretary had issued guidelines to celebrate Uthram Pooja on May 31st and continue celebrating Uthram pooja in future, regularly and also to celebrate June 5th as the 346th anniversary of Chathrapathi Shivaji Maharajas's Coronation - Haindavi

Swaraj Day. NEC requested the Govt for opening of temples with restrictions, to enable survival of the employees dependant upon temples.
